Letter of Intent

The Signatories hereby declare their intention to:

- I. Supply the EU market in 2014 with chargers that meet the existing European standards for products within the scope of the MoU on harmonisation of a charging capability for mobile phones, June 5, 2009.
- II. Work towards the harmonisation of a charging capability for future generations of mobile phones, while considering:
 - The existing DIGITALEUROPE position paper on future work on chargers for mobile phones
 - The power needs for future generations of mobile devices and their associated charging technologies
 - The transition from the existing European standards for mobile phone chargers to potentially new European standards developed by Standards Development Organisations should make specific EU regulation unnecessary
 - That minimum geographical area should be the European Union, but aiming towards a global reach
 - Any future industry self-commitment must be open to all interested manufacturers independent of DIGITALEUROPE membership.
- III. Regularly report on the progress of this work under item II to the European Commission and to other interested parties.
