



Our Project capabilities have hugely grown over the last years

Revenue from projects




Over half of members have experience in EU projects

OPPORTUNITY: Strengthen DE's Project Governance, access strategic projects on critical technologies & engage new stakeholders

Rationale

- Project and Policy units are very distinct in nature, required staff expertise and skills and financing models;
- Establishing a separation of duties between these units, as some other associations do, would allow DIGITALEUROPE to:
 - maintain focus on its core advocacy activities;
 - expand our project portfolio through access to strategic EUfunded projects in critical tech areas like AI or cyber, which are subject to strict EU control and ownership requirements;
 - Closer engage with a broader network of stakeholders (e.g. Research Institutes & Universities) without affecting existing policy work or membership;
 - ensure **financial self-sustainability** of the projects structure.



SOLUTION: Establishment of a distinct legal entity, governed by EU27 NTAs and DE, with associate free membership for Corporates

Governance

- Automatic full membership with voting rights to NTAs (EU controlled) at no additional cost
- Automatic, non-voting membership offered to Corporate members at no additional cost
- Associate membership for universities and research centers at a low fee
- Governance model, to be further discussed with lawyers and approved by ExB

Operations

 Apart from limited set-up cost (approx. 40K), full financial self-sustainability through project funding
