


**Intro** **POLICY PRIORITIES**

DIGITALEUROPE categorises the policy issues we work on along four categories:

- **CATEGORY 1** issues are the most strategic files on which DIGITALEUROPE concentrates most of its advocacy work, both from a position-making and outreach perspective;
- **CATEGORY 2** issues are important policy files which deserve a medium level of advocacy;
- **CATEGORY 3** issues are policy files that we follow and where we mostly engage at technical level.
- **CATEGORY 4** issues are policy files we monitor and provide space for discussion amongst members, but for which we do not foresee any specific deliverable or advocacy activity.
